- Respite service is based on availability of individual service units on the recipient's Notice of Action. ASI will monitor the availability of units.
- ASI will provide trained staff in accordance with current State & Federal regulation (460 IAC 6-14-4 Training)
- Private Pay is available

**SERVICES NOT INCLUDED**

- Respite care shall not be used as day/child care to allow the persons normally providing care to go to work.
- Respite care shall not be used as day/child care to allow the persons normally providing care to go to school.
- Respite care shall not be used to provide service to a member while member is attending school.
- Respite care may not be used to replace skilled nursing services that should be provided under the Medicaid State Plan.
- Services provided by the parent of a minor child or the individual's spouse.
- Respite care must not duplicate any other service being provided under the individual's Plan of Care/Individual Service Plan (POC/ISP).
- Reimbursement for room and board.
- Services provided to an individual living in a licensed facility based setting.
- The cost of registration fees or the cost of recreational activities (for example, camp).
- When the service of Adult Foster Care or Children's Foster Care is being furnished to the individual.

Respite care provides short term breaks that relieve stress, restore energy, and promote balance in your life. Working with family members or friends may be difficult, but Abilities Services, Inc. (ASI) provides respite care options and strategies that you may not be aware of.



## WHAT WE PROVIDE

- Assistance with toileting and feeding
- Assistance with daily living skills, including assistance with accessing the community and community activities
- Assistance with grooming and personal hygiene
- Meal preparation, serving and cleanup
- Administration of medications
- Supervision
- Individual Services
- Group services (unit rate divided by consumers served)

Staffing will be ensured with 30 or more days prior notice from the recipient's primary care giver.

Less than 30-days notice will be based on availability of and access to trained employees.



## WHAT RECIPIENT'S PRIMARY CARE GIVER AGREES TO PROVIDE

- An adequate living environment where services are to be provided.
- Medications and related supplies needed during the period services are provided.
- Funds for the recipient if community outings are requested, i.e., meals, movies, bowling, etc...
- At least 30 days notice prior to services to ensure staffing. Less than 30 days notice will be based on availability & access to trained employees.
- Reimbursement for additional services that exceed the recipient's current Notice of Action at the current rate at the time of services.
